

Canteen Manual

Olympus

General

The student canteens can be found on the ground floor of the Huygens building, in the 1-corridor: the North Canteen and South Canteen. These canteens are not owned by Olympus, but are managed by Olympus. They are kept tidy by everyone who uses the canteens. This includes the boards of the member associations of Olympus, the committees of the associations that use the canteens, but also the individual student. The canteens close at 21:15 and you are supposed to be out of the building by 21:30.

At the end of the document you can find a map of the spaces around the canteens. The numbers in the map correspond to the numbers in the rest of the document.

Space between the canteens

Between the canteens, when you walk down the stairs, there is a small hall. Here are two coat racks and waste containers (glass, plastic, and paper). Behind the door is another staircase to the downstairs toilets.

Associations per canteen

In the North Canteen, students from BeeVee (Biology), Thalia (Computing Science and Information Sciences), DESDA (Mathematics) and CognAC (Artificial Intelligence) can be found. The South Canteen is home to Marie Curie (Physics and Astronomy), Sigma (Chemistry, Molecular Life Sciences and Science) and Leonardo da Vinci (Science).

However, this does not mean that you cannot go to the canteen if your association is not there: everyone is welcome in both canteens.

South Canteen

1. Soda machine

- This machine can be found in the South Canteen, immediately upon entering on the right. The machine is notorious for its “surprise me” button: the only way to get cherry cola, cassis, and/or sprite cans outside the breaks!
- The Voorraadcie manages the soda machine and ensures that it is filled as best as possible.

- You are supposed to get your soda (and sweets) at the bar during the lunch break, because then the vending machines don't have to be filled that often.
2. Candy machine
 - The candy machine can be found next to the soft drink machine in the South Canteen. This machine is also managed by the Voorraadcie.
 3. Breakfast fridge
 - The breakfast fridge is a shared fridge where everyone can store food or drinks. Write down your name and the date, otherwise it will be thrown away! The breakfast fridge is managed by the Chief of Faculty Affairs of Olympus, who ensures that the fridge stays clean and tidy.
 4. Beer fridge
 - The beer fridge can be found in the South Canteen. Here, if someone from the Voorraadcie has opened the fridge, beer can be purchased at a reasonable price.
 - Of course the same applies here as with borrels: the beer is not allowed outside the canteens, you have to deal with it responsibly, no alcohol before 16:00 and people younger than the age of 18 are not allowed to consume alcohol.
 5. Percolators and cookers
 - Percolators for tea and coffee can also be reserved at the Voorraadcie. They can be found in the cupboard at the front of the bar. There are also percolators on the counter behind the bar, which must remain there for use in the canteen.
 - The cookers can be found under the counter. This does not work on normal sockets. If you do not know how it works, please contact the Voorraadcie.
 6. Games and bookcase
 - Everyone can get something to play or read from the games and bookcase for use in the North or South Canteen. Please put it back when you are done.
 7. Tables and chairs

8. Standing tables
 - In the North Canteen there are standing tables that can be reserved at the Voorraadcie, see point **Reservations** for more information. Do you need standing table covers? For the different possibilities, contact the Olympus Board via olympus@science.ru.nl.
9. Warming trays
 - The warming trays can be found in the cupboards under the bar.

Both canteens

10. Projector

- An HD projector is available in the North Canteen. The projector can be reserved by anyone. A projector is also present in the South Canteen, but it is not in HD.

11. Couches

- The furniture of the canteens consists largely of second-hand couches. As long as you keep the couches tidy and lift them when you want to move them, you can use them freely.

12. Marietje (music installation)

- In the South Canteen you have to e-mail to get an account before you can request music. Ask an older-years for the correct address.
- To request music in the North Canteen, go to marietje-noord.science.ru.nl. If it is the first time, you can create an account with your science-login.

13. Cutlery/crockery/mugs

- Mugs, crockery, and cutlery can be found in the cupboards and drawers of the bar. Anyone can use this, as long as it stays in the canteens. Of course you must ensure that it is cleaned afterwards and put back in the cupboards.

14. Mug hook

- Behind both bars there are hooks with mugs on them. To get a hook, mail to mok@science.ru.nl.

15. Sandwiches

- During the breaks, toasties are sold in both canteens. For the price of 50 cents per toasty. You can get a maximum of 2 toasties per person. At the bar there is a toasty list where you can place a request for a toasty. Whoever comes first, gets served first, but Tosticie members always get priority.

16. Coffee

- You can get cheap coffee in both canteens (10 cents per coffee). In the South Canteen this is managed by the Voorraadcie, in the North Canteen by BeeVee. The Senseo speaks for itself, but when making coffee in the South Canteen, ask someone how it works.

Outside the canteens

17. URD¹-cart

- In the 1-corridor, before the stairs to the canteens, the URD cart can be found on the left. After the use of plates and/or cutlery etc. from the URD, put it on this cart. This keeps our tableware separate from the URD its tableware.

18. Belinda

- There is another vending machine in the 1-corridor: Belinda. This machine is meant for savoury snacks. There are also occasional sweet snacks for sale such as Kinder Buenos. Sometimes dice, playing cards, and bicycle lights are also available.

Boardrooms

The boardrooms can be found above the North Canteen. If you have a question about your association, you can go here.

Terminal room

There is a terminal room opposite to the boardrooms. Here you can find 12 computers that can be used to work. This room is managed by the University.

BBB-room

Next to the terminal room you can find the BBB-room. The BBB board works here to organise the Bèta Bedrijven Beurs each year.

Reservations

The canteens can be reserved by anyone with a Basic Borrelbrevet (BBB), for use by member associations. Reservations can be made via voorraadcie.nl.

Borrels

Borrels can be organised in the canteens by members of Olympus. For this you need to have a Basic Borrelbrevet (BBB). Ask your board about the possibilities to get a BBB.
